Tadhg P. Begley obtained his B.Sc. degree from the National University of Ireland and his Ph.D. from Caltech working with Peter Dervan. He carried out postdoctoral studies with Wolfgang Oppolzer (Geneva) and with Chris Walsh (MIT) before beginning his independent career at Cornell in 1986. Tadhg moved to Texas A&M in 2009 where he is the D. H. R. Barton and Robert A. Welch Professor of Chemistry. His research interests center around the mechanistic enzymology of cofactor biosynthesis and catabolism. He has coauthored "The Organic Chemistry of Biological Pathways" with John McMurry and has edited The Wiley Encyclopedia of Chemical Biology and a volume of Comprehensive Natural Products

Chemistry on cofactors. His research has been recognized by an honorary D.Sc. degree from the National University of Ireland, a MERIT award from NIH and the Repligen Award in the Chemistry of Biological Processes from the American Chemical Society.
